UCLA Update on Exhibit 7.1
Graduate Degree Programs Overview
June 2015

Graduate-level work in both academic and professional degree programs is inherently different from work at the undergraduate level. As part of UCLA's most recent accreditation cycle, the Graduate Council of the Academic Senate set campus-wide learning outcomes expectations for students that are demonstrable through their thesis or dissertation work. All departments endorsed those expectations. Since that review, we have taken important steps to further clarify those expectations and strengthen the Academic Senate Program Review process, as part of broader efforts to support continuous enrollment, timely progress and degree completion. A campus discussion of graduate professional development core competencies for graduate students is also under way.

Graduate capstone experience: We have reviewed and updated WASC Table 7.1, correcting legacy errors and ensuring that all department and degree names are up-to-date. In Spring 2015, the UCLA Academic Senate approved a regulation change that will lead to more precise descriptions of non-thesis capstone projects for master's degrees, requiring a clear distinction between "comprehensive examinations" that are truly exams, vs. those that are individual or group projects, and mandating mechanisms for evaluating individual efforts as part of group projects. The degree program requirements for 2015–16 will reflect these changes, which will be incorporated into future versions of Table 7.1. We expect that the increased transparency regarding the capstone requirement will help students better understand what is expected of them, supporting timely progress and success in degree completion.

Academic Senate Program Reviews: The Graduate Council continues to refine the Program Review process. Departments and interdepartmental degree programs are now asked to provide information on graduate professional development and career services in addition to placement information.

Program requirements: We have amplified our efforts to assist programs in crafting clear, accurate, and complete information about their official degree requirements, which made available on the Graduate Division website: (<https://grad.ucla.edu/gasaa/library/pgmrqintro.htm>). We are creating a template that standardizes some information and options, consulting with programs that seek to make changes, and developing an easier process for accessing and updating the requirements. Developing this streamlined process is a key element of the ongoing Graduate Division website redesign project.

Continuous enrollment: The University of California, like most AAU universities, expects students who matriculate into graduate degree programs to be enrolled continuously until they complete their degrees, as this supports timely progress and success in degree completion. Over the past four years, we have clarified policies and procedures to support this goal. From 2011 through 2013, a concerted effort was made to recapture students who had lapsed student status and enable them to complete their degrees. Students are no longer allowed to take leaves of absence (a non-enrolled status) to conduct research toward their degrees; by enrolling, we can ensure continued access to research resources and faculty mentoring. When appropriate, students now make use of *in absentia* registration, through which doctoral students who have advanced to candidacy can conduct research outside of California and pay significantly reduced tuition and fees. Additionally, the Graduate Council approved changes in our administration of the Filing Fee that will be implemented over the next two years. These changes will ensure that students who are actively engaged in research, writing, and capstone projects maintain their student status, which confers access to essential resources that include financial support through fellowships, teaching and research apprenticeships.

Electronic thesis and dissertation filing: In 2012, UCLA implemented an electronic thesis and dissertation filing process that enables filing and faculty approvals to be completed entirely online. As part of this effort, we revised the thesis and dissertation filing guidelines to provide clear guidance on the inclusion of published articles, co-authored work and multi-media components. The requirement for students to deposit their theses and dissertations in the institutional repository, copyright ownership, and the instructions for time-limited embargoes, has also been clarified.

Time to degree: We have created a process for periodically providing departments with time-to-degree data to increase awareness of this metric of student progress and promote best practices. On an ongoing basis, the Graduate Division and Graduate Council (through the Program Reviews) work with departments to refine degree requirements and to improve mentoring, financial support and department climate, all of which contribute to student progress and success in degree completion. For example, the Graduate Council recently reaffirmed the policy articulated in its 1993 document, “Policies and Recommendations to Improve Time-To-Degree in UCLA’s Graduate Degree Programs” (<https://grad.ucla.edu/gasaa/library/gcttdeg.pdf>). One element of this policy is to require at least annual reviews of each student’s progress. A toolkit to support the requirement and best practices in mentoring will be developed in 2015–16. This effort builds on mentoring workshops offered through our campus career consortium and the individual development plan tools that are now available to UCLA graduate students and postdoctoral scholars.

Student support: The Graduate Division, with advice and consent of the Graduate Council, engages in an ongoing process to improve the mechanisms for providing fellowship support, both as block grants to departments and as competitive awards to individual students. To encourage faculty to compete for extramural training grants, the Graduate Division implemented a formal program to provide matching funds that leverage student support funds provided by the funding agency. In 2015, a new initiative was created through which the Graduate Division partners with departments to cover any gap in the cost-of-education (tuition and fees) not covered by individual extramural fellowship awards. These efforts aim not only to increase the financial support provided to graduate students, but also to encourage students to prepare successful fellowship applications as part of their professional development.

Graduate professional development and core competencies: In 2014–15, the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and Vice Provost for Graduate Education jointly charged a faculty workgroup to assess the availability of and needs for graduate professional and career development services at UCLA. Their report was presented to the campus in Spring 2015. It documents the progress made over the past three years to expand campus collaborations to provide these services, the rapidly increasing number of events and student participants, and the need for greater attention to supporting students in their exploration of multiple career trajectories, within and outside academia. The report has also served to initiate a discussion of core competencies for graduate students and how they can be developed through co-curricular activities.

The graduate experience: With the approval of the Graduate Council, the Graduate Division this month started using the AAUDE (AAU Data Exchange) survey in place of the UCLA doctoral exit survey that has been used for several decades. Using the AAUDE survey will make it possible for UCLA to compare itself with peer institutions across many dimensions of doctoral study (student support, time to degree, satisfaction, placement, etc.) as part of the Academic Senate program review process. We are now looking at whether the survey can/should be adapted for master’s degree students, whom we do not currently survey upon graduation.
